The objective of the Classic Yacht Association is to promote and encourage an interest in the preservation, restoration and maintenance of fine old power driven pleasure craft. Established in 1970, the Association has become a major influence in the growing appreciation of the classic yacht.

The Association welcomes three types of membership:

Regular (classic or vintage) membership for those who meet the qualifications listed below;

Affiliate membership for those who have an interest in old wooden power vessels;

Associate membership for CYA Regular members who no longer own a qualified classic or vintage vessel.

*The qualifications for **Regular** membership are: The vessel shall be a power driven pleasure boat of good design, construction and maintenance, which shows no exterior alterations that detract from the designer's original intent. A **classic** designation indicates launch on or prior to December 31, 1942; a **vintage** designation indicates launch after December 31, 1942 and on or prior to December 31, 1959. (Article IV, Classic Yacht Association By-Laws)*

Attach the following documents to this application:

1. At least one 3"x5" or larger photograph showing a broadside view of the boat in the water. This photo should have been taken within the last six months and the image of the boat must be sufficiently large and unobstructed to permit an evaluation of special features of the boat. Write the name of the boat and the date of the photo on the back of each photo with a soft tipped felt pen.
2. A typewritten statement on the background of the boat. This should include all known history about the boat, including former owners, historical events, restoration activities or history, special design or construction features, and special or unique uses of the boat.

When completed, this application and all attachments should be sent to the Commodore of your home fleet.
