

Public Information Access Policy of the Classic Yacht Association ("the Association")

Adopted by the Board of Directors on June 14, 2020

The Public Information Access Policy describes the Association's compliance with standard practices with regard to the following:

- A tax-exempt organization is required to make its Forms 1023 (or 1024 if applicable), 990, and 990-T (501(c)(3)s only) available for public inspection.
- A tax-exempt organization must make its governing documents, conflict of interest policy, and financial statements available to the public.

The Association will publish its 990 form, plus any other required IRS forms on the Classic Yacht Association website, as well as its governing documents, bylaws, conflict of interest policy and financial statements.
