These facilities are located on the active USCG base on the Seattle waterfront (Pier 36, 1519 Alaskan Way South, Seattle, WA, 98134). Parking is available on base.

The tour will start at 10:00am with the VTS and continue at the museum at 11:00am

In order to participate in these tours, you need to do the following:

- **Register on-line at the CYA website.** Go to the PNW Events page at <https://cya.wildapricot.org/pnw-events>.
- We must provide the following information to security personnel on the base prior to the event:
 - First and last name (as it appears on your driver’s license).
 - Driver’s license number.

So please provide this information as part of your registration.

- **Bring your driver’s license to show security personnel for entry to the base prior to the tour.**

The maximum number of people for the tour is 30. You must register prior to March 1, 2024 so we can provide your personal information to the Coast Guard security personnel prior to the visit.
